A trickster, this detective. Full of taunts and feints and sly stratagems. Psychological-warfare artist. His entire body throbbed from his neck to the tips of his nine toes. His legs were the worst, filled with hot twisting agony. Cops at the doorstep, the lunatic bitch with the chair, the clergyman's curse—all this amounted to more than even a committed man could handle. Get out of the present, go for the future. Devil mountains, sacred islands, sacramental rivers and cities, Jesuits: These spiritual references at every turn made Junior uneasy. This was a haunted night, no doubt about that.
